Location Information

Fonner Park (Home of the Nebraska State Fair), 700 E Stolley Park Rd, Grand Island, NE 68802 is the location of all 2022 Junior National events. **The Junior National trailer entrance route will be different for Saturday at 3 PM versus Saturday after 5 PM/Sunday morning.** For arrivals on Saturday, June 18 at 3 PM, please enter the grounds through Gate 3A on Stolley Park Rd to drive by tie-outs then to follow the route to the trailer staging area west of Tie-Outs. The trailer arrival route from 5 PM on Saturday through Sunday, June 19 will enter the grounds via Gate 2 on Stolley Park Rd to begin the unloading process. (See maps for trailer unloading route details). Vehicle/Day parking will be located east of the Five Points Bank Arena and Cattle Barn. Trailer Parking will be in the grass lot northwest of Tie-Outs.

Boarders Inn & Suites, Ramada Midtown and Best Western Plus are conveniently located within two miles from the fairgrounds south on Locust Street. Please note - *Hotel cancellation and change policies are 48 hours prior to scheduled arrival.*

Check-In

Earliest arrival for cattle will be Saturday, June 18 at 3 PM and to Tie-Outs ONLY. **No admittance to the barn nor washrack are allowed due to cleaning and setup for the Junior National event. The earliest time the Cattle Barn may be open for move-in is 5 PM on Saturday, June 18. The facility manager will designate the official barn opening time. Please note: Barns will open no earlier than 5 p.m. on Saturday.** (Cattle must be on the grounds by 12 p.m. Noon, Sunday, June 19. Barns will be open for unloading all night, Saturday, June 18.) All registration certificates, health papers and conference registrations must be checked-in before Sunday, June 19, 12 p.m. Noon.

Cattle Check-in will be held outside of Five Points Bank Arena under the west overhang. **Each animal entered for exhibition will have tattoos checked.** Make sure the tattoo or firebrand number is legible and corresponds to the registration certificate. **Animals without and/or non-legible tattoos or firebrand numbers will be disqualified and ineligible to show.** All bulls born on or before August 31, 2021 must have a permanent nose ring. In addition to having tattoos checked at Cattle Check-in, steers will be weighed and sifted on Monday, June 20 at 7:30 a.m.

Health papers must be issued for exhibition purposes. **All junior cattle must be listed on a CVI with Official Identification listed.** (Registration tattoos accompanied with registration papers accepted). Additional statement required on CVI's: 'All cattle are returning to the state of origin.' Rules and regulations of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture must be adhered to. Leadership Conference Check-in where you will receive your official Junior National name tag/conference ticket, conference event booklet and t-shirt and conduct contest check-in will be held in the Pinnacle Bank Expo Center. This includes check-in of speeches, art, posters, and scrapbooks.

On Sunday afternoon, we will be holding an adult, chaperone and advisor meeting in Pinnacle Bank Expo Center at 2:00 p.m. At least one adult representative from each state must attend and we recommend attendance of first-time participants. Team forms for Quiz Bowl, Team Fitting, and Team Sales will be available at check-in and at this meeting, please bring completed forms to the Show Office by 9 a.m., Monday, June 20. At that point, we will do our best to fill any incomplete teams.

Stalling/Bedding

Bulk base bedding for stalls and tie-outs will be provided. Please remember all tie-outs and barn stalling will be assigned by state/affiliate. Please work together as a state/affiliate. **No pens or tents are allowed in tie-outs.** No washing animals in tie-outs. Tie-outs are cleaned every afternoon at 1 PM. All items except manure to be disposed of should be clear of the tie-out aisles by that time. Cleaning trailers in the trailer parking area is prohibited. **Port-A-Cools and butt fans are not allowed** at Fonner Park/Nebraska State Fairgrounds. Please bring extension cords for electricity.

Feed store service provided by Aurora Co-op will be available on the grounds, west of the Cattle Barn. Products will include shavings, feed and hay. A complete product list is attached. Feed store hours will be announced at the adult, chaperone, advisor meeting. Outside bedding is permitted.

All Junior National participants exhibiting cattle must participate in at least one contest at Junior National. Please review each contests' rules. Online entry submissions are required for photo, graphic design and interview/resume contests. Online submissions must be sent to jrcharolais@gmail.com by midnight, June 1.

The use of paint, flock, powder and/or powder-based products is prohibited in all AICA and AIJCA sanctioned shows. The Weaver Livestock Showmanship Contest is a non-fit competition. Official 2022 Junior National t-shirts must be worn during all shows except Showmanship. The Group Photo will be taken at 4 p.m. prior to the Opening Ceremonies. State/affiliate groups to follow at the photo backdrop in Five Points Bank Arena. Shows Wednesday, June 22 - Friday, June 24 can be viewed live online at www.CharolaisUSA.com or on the AICA YouTube page. The banquet held Thursday, June 23 has a business casual dress code. All entries will be released following the conclusion of the Show on Friday, June 24. All cattle must be off the grounds by Saturday, June 25, Noon.

The AIJCA Junior National Show & Leadership Conference is a non-alcohol event. The consumption of alcoholic beverages at the AIJCA Junior National will not be tolerated.


